Subject: RoHS Compliance

Dear Valued Customer:

In February 2003, the European Union issued Directive 2002/95/EC on the Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS). This RoHS directive requires producers of electrical and electronic equipment to eliminate the use of six environmentally sensitive substances:

- Lead
- Mercury
- Cadmium
- Hexavalent Chromium
- PBB and PBDE flame-retardants.

Use of these substances must be eliminated in electrical and electronic products sold in the European Union beginning July 1, 2006.

Thomas & Skinner alnico magnets and transformer laminations do not contain any of the prohibited substances. Thomas & Skinner products are fully compliant with the RoHS requirements.
